



CONTROLLING BLOOD PRESSURE SCREEN



On the Controlling Blood Pressure page view your pharmacy's list of patients who are eligible for a blood pressure reading through the CBP program. You can:

- Select the payer you wish to view opportunities for from the drop-down menu.
- Click the arrow next to "Controlling Blood Pressure" to access links for CBP program guides.
 - Patient conversation resource guide
 - Decision tree for use during/after readings
 - Additional program information
- Track your progress towards the maximum payout for your pharmacy.
- At the far right of the patient's row is the "Documentation Status"
 - Completed: blood pressure reading already documented
 - Not Started: patient eligible for paid reading, but documentation has not been started.
 - Click the pencil next to the status to access the patient documentation popup.
- Patients with an "already completed" will be highlighted with a green check.
- Number of Patients and Page Navigation
 This screen defaults to ten patients per page. Toggle to increase the number of patients per page. Click the arrows at the bottom of the page to navigate between pages.



DOCUMENTATION STEPS

Select yes or no depending on if you were able to obtain a reading.



When NO is selected, the patient opportunity will return for intervention after 21 days.

You will receive a series of follow up questions based on your response to the first question.
