



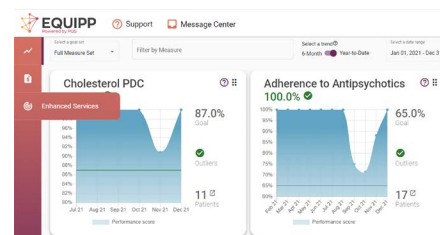
## PROGRAM INFORMATION

The Longitudinal Adherence Monitoring Program (LAMP) is designed to improve and maintain medication adherence for targeted patients while rewarding high performing pharmacies for documented interventions and patients that are adherent (Proportion of Days Covered or “PDC” of 80% or better) at the end of the calendar year. The program will evaluate the following core adherence measures: Diabetes PDC, RASA PDC, and Cholesterol PDC for the year-to-date measurement period of January 1 - December 31, 2024.

## PROGRAM STEPS IN EQUIPP

### Step #1: Navigate to the Enhanced Services Page WEEKLY!

- Targeted patients for LAMP will be displayed in the Enhanced Services section of EQUIPP.
- After logging into EQUIPP, navigate to the bullseye on the left-hand side. Select “Longitudinal Adherence Monitoring Program” to view your eligible patients.
- Patients with an arrow next to their last name have multiple encounters available (click to expand and view all opportunities).




### Step #2: Document!

- Both active and previously documented opportunities will be listed under the patient. Opportunities that have expired without documentation will not be listed.
- To document an intervention, click on “Not Started” in the documentation status column.
- The documentation window will pop up. Complete the applicable questions after speaking with the patient. Please note that the documentation will apply to all currently available intervention types.
- If the intervention requires validation, fill the prescription after documenting the intervention. Prescriptions fills must be filled on or before “Target Refill Date.”

## PAYMENT

Payment in this program will be based upon completing encounters with targeted patients provided by the health plan via EQUIPP. Types of encounters include: Quarterly Check-Ins, Extended Days Supply Conversion, Final Fill, and Year-End Adherence Bonus.
